Location Hours:

East Community Center:

- Monday-Friday 9a - 12p
- Saturday 10a -12p

Patti Johnson Wilson Center:

- Monday-Thursday 7:30a - 1p and 3p - 7:30p
- Friday 7:30a - 1p and 3p - 6p
- Saturday 8a - 2p
- Sunday 12p – 5 p

Rules:

- For ages 6 weeks to 8 years of age.
- Maximum use of 2 hours per visit.
- Parents must provide diaper supplies

Drop-in Child Care Health Practices:

In order for us to maintain a safe and healthy place for children do not bring sick or contagious children to the drop-in child care. If a child shows signs of fever or infection, we reserve the right to return the child to you. Signs of illness include, but are not limited to:

- Severe or persistent cough
- Unexplained rashes or spots
- Yellow or green discharge
- Sore throat
- Temperature over 100 degrees
- Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
- Any skin infection or lice

Please do not bring your child back until they have been symptom free or on antibiotics for a full 24 hours. YWCA staff is unable to provide or dispense medicine to children.
